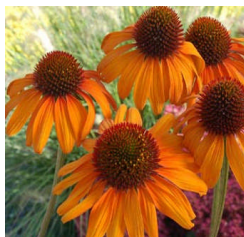

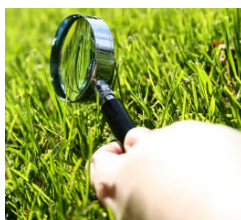
Thursday-Sunday, August 18-21
