What are Cannas? Cannas are rhizomes grown for their beautiful tropical foliage and bold floral color. Ideal for borders and containers.

When can we plant these plants in the landscape? We recommend that you plant canna rhizomes directly into the garden after May 1st. Rhizomes can be started in pots for a head start.

How hardy are these plants? Officially they are only hardy in zones 7-10, (we are Zone 5, nearly 6).

What type of soil is best? Rich, well-drained organic soil is ideal. Plant 3-4 inches deep, 12 inches apart.

What kind of light do they require? They grow in full sun.

How much water do they need? Water regularly during the growing season.

How should they be fertilized? Use bulb food when planting, apply balanced fertilizer monthly.

How do we winterize canna bulbs? Dig rhizomes and store at 41-50 degrees in peat or vermiculite.
