



Lilies

What are Lilies? Lilies are hardy bulbs grown for their dazzling colors and striking flower forms.

When can we plant these plants in the landscape? We recommend that you plant lilies directly into the garden as soon as the soil can be worked. Lilies bloom mid-spring to early fall.

How hardy are these plants? Officially they are hardy in zones 3-9, (we are Zone 5, nearly 6).

What type of soil is best? Well-drained organic soil is ideal. Standing water should be avoided.

What kind of light do they require? They grow in full sun to light shade.

<u>How much water do they need?</u> Water regularly during the growing season.

How should they be fertilized? Use bulb food when planting; apply balanced fertilizer monthly.

<u>Special notes</u>: Because they are winter hardy here, trim plant stems after frost. Deer repellent is recommended.
